Puppy Kindergarten (Age: 10 weeks – 5 months)

This one hour class meets six times per session to cover house-breaking, biting, chewing, jumping, barking, grooming, coming when called, walking, sit-stay, down-stay, and exercises for young dogs. A 4ft. leash is required for class. **No class 2/17.** PDNA (ms)

Intermediate Obedience (Age: 8 months & up)

Advanced Obedience (Age: 8 months & up)

Canine Good Citizen (CGC) Test (Age: All dogs and ages)

Have your dog certified as a Canine Good Citizen by completing ten exercises: accepting a friendly stranger, sitting politely for petting, appearance and grooming, out for a walk (heeling), walking thru a crowd, sit & down on command while staying in place, recall, reaction to another dog, reaction to distraction and supervised separation. Test group times are scheduled with an evaluator. A 4ft or 6ft leash is required for the test, as well as grooming brush/comb. Do not have your dog on a pinch or electronic collar or head halter. No treats during the test, but bring them to celebrate after. PDNA (ms)
